ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:

For appearing in the BMS*/BBA(FIA)/B.A. (Hons.) Business Economics Joint Admission Test

- (a) The candidate should have passed or have appeared in March/April 2015 in Senior Secondary School Examination of CBSE or any other examination considered equivalent by the University of Delhi.
- (b) The General Category candidate should secure an aggregate of atleast 60% marks in his/her XII class examination in four papers including English, Mathematics and other two subjects from the list of elective subjects as approved by University of Delhi. Minimum percentage of marks for OBC is 54%, for SC& ST pass marks in qualifying examination, for PwD 55%, for CW 55%. Other conditions are same as for the General Category.



List A

The following Discipline subjects offered by the University of Delhi for admission to undergraduate courses must be treated as Academic/Elective subjects for the purpose of undergraduate admissions. All other subjects offered by different boards may be treated as non-elective. All the Discipline subjects must have at least a 70% component of theory exams (theory exam does not include internal assessment/continuous evaluation etc.) in the qualifying exam for the purpose of being treated as academic/elective subject.

1. *Accountancy will be treated as equivalent to Commerce wherever any board is not offering commerce as a subject.
2. Biology/Biotechnology and Business Studies will be treated as academic/elective subjects.
3. #Music, and #Physical Education will be treated as academic/elective only for Honours in Music and Physical Education, respectively.

- (c) The candidate should have obtained pass mark in each of the four papers considered for computing the aggregate.

- (d)** The candidate must produce the confirmed result and marksheet of the qualifying examination on the day of the Group Discussion and Personal Interview to be eligible for the process of admission to the BMS*/BBA(FIA) programs. Candidates who do not have the confirmed mark sheet will not be entertained under any circumstances.
In case of a student seeking admission to the B.A. (Hons.) Business Economics program the confirmed result and marksheet of the qualifying examination must be produced on the day of the counselling.
- (e)** The category certificate (OBC- non creamy layer/SC/ST/PwD/CW), in the name of the candidate, must be produced:
On the day of the interview and group discussion (for BMS*, BBA(FIA))
On the day of counselling (for B.A.(Hons.) Business Economics)
- (f)** Compartment cases of current year will not be considered for admission.
- (g)** Candidates who have appeared in the class XII examination in 2015 and who repeat a paper for improvement to gain eligibility shall not be considered for admission in the current year.
- (h)** Foreign Students seeking admission to BMS*/BBA(FIA)/B.A.(Hons) Business Economics course(s) against the prescribed quota of seats earmarked for them, shall have to apply through the Foreign Students Advisor as per the Delhi University rules.
