Meeting of the IQAC was held on 3rd May, 2018 at 10 am in the college premises. Attendance Sheet is enclosed.

Mr. Anurag Sunder, Mr. Jiten Chopra, Mr. Chirag Mittal and Mr. Asheet Makhija (alumni and recruiter category) had expressed their inability to attend the meeting. Ms. Kavita Rastogi, Dr. Anamika Gupta and Ms. Deepti Khatri were on leave.

It was recorded that the minutes of the meeting of IQAC held on 29th September, 2017 were approved by circulation without any observations received there on. The minutes were read and confirmed.

The Annual Quality Assurance Report (2016-17) was placed on record. Different sections of the AQAR 2016-17 were taken up. Following emerged from the discussion:

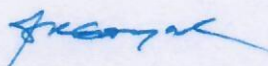
1. The college is in the process of making available a medical room to the college fraternity. It was suggested that the college should have full time medical services in the college as the hostel facilities are soon going to commence.
2. The University team has inspected the college facilities to grant approval for B.Sc (Operational Research) and M.Sc (Operation Research) – tutorial classes only. The letter from the University is awaited. It was further noted that the college had proposed three courses but the University is yet to follow the due processes.
3. It was reported that the college Principal alongwith Principals of 20 other colleges (which are 'A' accredited by NAAC) were invited by the UGC to attend a meeting w.r.t. understanding the issue of grant of autonomous status to the colleges. It was clarified from the UGC authorities and MHRD officials that the funding will not be affected in the colleges seeking autonomy. The colleges will be having the freedom to run their own UG/PG/Ph.D courses, change the curriculum and they will take their own examination. However, every college will have to follow the due process for seeking autonomy.
4. It was reported that the University is providing some financial databases for research by the students and faculty. It was suggested that data bases with advance features should be made available to the college fraternity. Further, in future the college should work on such research projects that can help the college in creating its own databases.
5. It was suggested that the college should promote providing consultancy services, projects, summer schools and workshops. This way the college will be able to generate resources which can be used for the purposes for which resources are scarce.

6. It was proposed to include some parents in the IQAC.
7. It was suggested that "Intent" should be explained/reported before "Vision" & "Mission" of the institution.
8. It was suggested that the college should make efforts to get some certifications / ratings / rankings for itself so that the world knows better about the college.
9. It was suggested that the students of the college can be involved in making the college building more eco-friendly.
10. It was suggested that efforts need to be made to improve connect with the college alumni.

The AQAR (2016-17) was adopted.

It was noted that the two year term of the current IQAC was over and that a new IQAC is to be constituted as per NAAC regulation.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
