### SSCBS gets Own Campus



### SSCBS becomes the only college to have Start-up Incubation Centre!



The college now has a fully functional Incubation Centre in the premises, supporting the students of the college with their entrepreneurial ambitions.

The company, SSCBS Innovation and Incubation Foundation (SIIF) was incorporated on October 6, 2016.

During July – December, 2016, students of the college have been coached and motivated to develop new innovative ideas and start-ups. External industry experts, entrepreneurs and alumni of college were invited to meet students and also to hold idea review sessions.

Rigorous process to select the CEO was carried out in December 2016. Selection Committee of 5 members included VC-NSIT, industry veterans and Principal-SSCBS. Based on the recommendations of the Selection Committee, Mr. Naresh Priyadarshi, joined SIIF as full-time CEO on January 9, 2017. He is an alumnus of SSCBS (class of 1991), and IIM Ahmedabad (class of 1997), with 25 years of experience in corporate leadership, people development, strategy and management consulting, in India and abroad.


### SSCBS Collaborates with CIMA for an Extended Course for it's Students

CIMA Accreditation Team has given SSCBS to Advance Route 1 (an elite partnership) to Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies. CIMA and SSCBS have signed LOI dated 22 April 2016, SSCBS wherein BBA & BMS students get an exemption of 9 papers from CIMA qualifications.

CIMA (The Chartered Institute of Management Accountants), founded in 1919, is the world's leading and largest professional body of management accountants, with members and students operating in 178 countries, working at the heart of business. CIMA members and students work in industry, commerce, the public sector and not-for-profit organisations. CIMA works closely with employers and sponsors leading-edge research, constantly updating its qualification, professional experience requirements and continuing professional development to ensure it remains the employers' choice when recruiting financially-trained business leaders.

This year, 50 students applied, out of which 40 students enrolled. 10 students have successfully completed the respective levels.

## IN-HOUSE PROJECT

Students have undertaken a number of in-house web-based projects.

These projects enable the smooth functioning of the student centric administrative activities of the college. These include:

**Web-based Time Table Management System (Displays the class-wise time table as day-wise and teacher-wise time table on-demand).**

**Web-based Attendance and Waivers Management System (The faculty can enter the attendance details online and the students can see their attendance in their respective login-ids).**

**Web-based Internal Assessment Management System (Facilitates internal assessment record management and enables the students to view their scores in their respective login-ids).**

**Web-based Feedback System (Students provide feedback through the online system. Compiled feedback is sent as a report to individual authorities).**



## BEST PRACTICES

1. Placement and Summer Internships Goal Better career opportunities Context College has a Career Development Centre (CDC), the Placement Cell of the college which serves as an interface between the students and the recruiters, offering a host of services in the areas of placements, internships, live projects, personal counseling and support, assistance in resume building and soft skills development. Practice Lectures and sessions with industry practitioners and regular industry interaction via industry visits, pre-placement talks, workshops and compulsory summer internships for the second year students help bring the academic and the corporate world closer for them. Out of 160 students, 107 students got the placement in an organization. 48 recruiters visited the campus and offered 125 offers.

2. Commitment for the Society Goal to develop socially responsible students. Context College has collaborated with Enactus (Entrepreneurial Action through Us), an international not for profit organization that works with business leaders and university students across the globe to develop outreach projects. Practice SSCBS chapter of ENACTUS has undertaken several outreach projects. Some of the projects are listed below: Project Akshar is a social enterprise that aims to empower marginalized communities (currently victims of drug abuse and domestic violence) by producing low cost environment friendly notebooks and marketing them to schools, educational institutions and corporates. Project Udaan, initiated in 2015 in the Kaloji district of Haryana, aims at imparting quality education and digital literacy to rural India by setting up computer labs that utilize e-waste and build sustainable entrepreneurial models that empower women. Project Raahat works towards eradicating open defecation and providing safe sanitation in urban slum communities. Project Khidki, our latest project, aims to eradicate malnutrition in children of the age bracket 06 years following a CMAM (Community based Management of Acute Malnutrition) approach.
