SSCBS widens it's curriculum horizon! Introduces Post Graduate Diploma



Envisioning the compelling need for professionals in the niche area of cyber security, **Institute** of Cyber Security and Law along with University of Delhi, has started one year post graduate diploma in cyber security and law.

Our college was the only college in the University Of Delhi, to be selected to start the **Post Graduate Diploma in Cyber Security and Law (PGDCSL)**. The college runs this course in the public-private partnership model, Lucideus Tech. Pvt. Ltd. is a private knowledge partner for this course. This is an advanced Penetration Testing & Information Security Training Engineering Program.

Certificate Courses give the students an edge

- Data Analytics: Expecting to build a solid foundation of business analytics, this course is started for imparting knowledge of machine learning and statistical methods for data analysis. The course provides sufficient knowledge of python programming language to use for machine learning algorithm and python/R programming for statistical methods, neural networks and deep learning.
- Applied Financial Technology: The Certificate Course on Applied Financial Technology at Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies, Delhi is jointly offered in association with YStart Innovation Labs under academic guidance of Department of Financial Studies (South Campus, University of Delhi). This 40-hours Course has been designed by YStart Innovation Labs under the academic direction of Department of Financial Studies (University of Delhi, South Campus) and University of Strathclyde (Glasgow, Scotland). The Course aims to make the students aware about the fast emerging technological disruptions in the field of financial technology (FinTech) by means of industry professionals and subject matter experts.

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IQAC INITIATIVES IN THE YEAR

Lufthansa Impact Week 8th-11th October, 2018



SSCBS collaborated with Lufthansa German Airlines to hold first ever workshop by them in Asia on design thinking, innovation and entrepreneurship. It was held for total period of six days in joint collaboration with AUD, DPSRU and SSCBS / SIIF. The workshop had 155 students and 35 coaches from these three institutes, and 25 coaches from Lufthansa Germany, and all these 200+ participants grouped in 21 teams were hosted at SSCBS, and generated as many great ideas. This gave our college immense popularity, praise and visibility across India and global network of Lufthansa.



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IQAC INITIATIVES IN THE YEAR

Incubation of Start-ups

SSCBS Innovation and Incubation Foundation (SIIF) held one comprehensive evaluation session for business proposals during this academic year, as the primary focus had been on supporting the ideas (27) approved in preceding 4 cohorts. More than 100 ideas were discussed through walk-ins / applications / references, and "Start-up Hunt" held jointly with TiE-NCR, DPSRU, and ANDC. All these which were further filtered / strengthened to have presentations at the evaluation panel held in November 2018. The pitches also included presentations from the existing incubatees which were ready for investment.

As an outcome of evaluation panel,

- Funding for 5 existing incubatees was approved
- Next round of funding for 1 existing funded incubatee was approved
- 3 new ideas were approved for incubation support without funding
- 2 new ideas were approved were provided incubation + funding support.

New initiatives / Associations

SIIF helped Yuva, e-cell team of the college to develop area within first floor of the campus where its members could interact with students for handling queries related to entrepreneurship.

SIIF is in active discussions with newly opened incubation cell at School of Open Learning, DU to derive synergy in mutual best practices.

Events – internal and external

SIIF actively helped Alumni Relations and Outreach Cell (AROC) at the college to hold Alumni Meet on February 24th, 2019. This was held after a long gap of about 6 years and was well attended by nearly 180 alumni.

SIIF collaborated with three other incubators of Delhi under the current initiative, and with TiE-NCR to build sector-based pipeline. TiE-NCR carried out marketing and visibility for the start-up hunt, and four incubators – SIIF, ANDC-IIF, DPSRU-IIF and AIACTR-IIF – had evaluations at their respective institutes to identify good potential start-ups.

Placement and SSCBS Support to Final Year Students

The Placement Season 2018-19 extended from August 2018 to June 2019 and witnessed 175+ offers extended to approximately 200 registered students. 70+ companies from sectors including

consulting, insurance, knowledge services, real estate, media, investment banking, PR, FMCG, IT, shipping, and financial services recruited from our college. Some of our coveted recruiters include Bain Capability Network, FTI Consulting, DE Shaw Group, Boston Consulting Group, EY, KPMG, Deloitte, Grant Thornton, CBRE, Inmobi, Praxis Global, Verity Knowledge Solutions, United Airlines, Ken Research and Wingify. Bain Capability Network and KPMG were the biggest recruiters with 15 and 16 offers



respectively. DE Shaw Group extended 11 offers and offered the highest package of INR 18 LPA. The average package was INR 7 LPA and around 80% of the registered students were placed till 10th May 2019.

The Placement Cell also witnessed a surge in the number of companies looking to hire experienced professionals and recruiting great talent from the alumni batches.

SSCBS Support for Placements to Final Year Students

Workshops and Seminars: Sessions hosted by third year students placed at prominent companies were organized for the first and second year students covering topics such as resume building, case interviews, guesstimates and quantitative finance. A session by Ms. Harleen Chadha was also organized on the theme 'Unleash the Leader Within'. KPMG India organized the semi-final round of their KICC competition at SSCBS.

Orientation for Placement and Internship Season 2019-20 was organised on 22nd April 2019.

Buddy Project aims to support second year students preparing for placements by seeking the assistance of the third-year placed students.

Placement Support through consolidated support material for the students provide an insight to the psychology of the recruiters in addition to the kind of questions the students may be asked.

Extension Activities

Project AVYA

A community based approach, aims to provide potable water solutions to urban slum communities by developing low cost, customised household filtration systems. This project was inaugurated on 31st March 2019 by the **Dr. Udit Raj**, **Minister of Parliament**.

Project PRAVAAH

It aims to provide holistic clean air solutions to each section of the society at affordable cost and enabling the skilled unemployed youth to raise their own livelihood. This Project will begin by the end of March.

Rotaract is the youth wing of Rotary International, which is a renowned global network of 1.2 million neighbours, friends, leaders and problem solvers across the globe. Rotaract Club of SSCBS was incepted in the college in the month of October' 18 and aims at bringing social changes with efficient scalability.

Extension Activities

Verve, the street play society of the college is a group of enthusiastic group of people with an aim to raise concerns that matter, making everyone realize the immense power they possess, the power to raise voices against injustice, to go against the conventions that weigh us down and breaking perceptions to initiate a movement and initiate a process of change. The society comprises of research based theatre and education of audience through the medium of artistic inspiration.

In the academic year 2018-2019, Verve produced its Annual Street Play Production 'Emotional Atyachaar', dealing with the issue of mental illnesses arising out of distressed relationships. The play was performed on more than 40 occasions. To promote non competitiveness and to reach the most relevant audience, the play was performed at more than 20 public locations.

On 11th April, 2019, Verve performed its second Street Play Production 'Vote Tu-De' in Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies under 'Voter's Awareness' campaign by Election Commission with the motive of encouraging youth to actively participate in the voting process during the general elections 2019.

To promote the ideals of non-competitiveness and social awareness, Verve organised 12th Edition of its Annual Event, Manthan 2019- An International Street Theatre Festival, from 22nd February, 2019- 2nd April,2019. During this period, More than 160 street theatre performances, involving 3000 artists, were organised across 13 countries like Nigeria, Kenya Morocco, South Africa with 24 international performances worldwide and in 63 cities in India. 23rd February witnessed 'Manthan Mohatsav' an event under which 45 teams from Delhi Collegiate Theatre Circuit performed their street plays at 17 different public locations in Delhi including locations like Jama Masjid, Humayun's Tomb, Lal Quila, New Delhi Railway Station and so on. Likewise, 'Manthan Ekaai' was organised on 27th March across the globe on the occasion of World Theatre Day, a day that witnessed 6 International performances, 25 teams performing at 9 public locations all over Delhi and performances in 12 States all together .The closing ceremony of Manthan 2019 was organised on 2nd April 2019 in the warm presence of two respected theatre practitioners Mr. Arvind Gaur, who is associated with Asmita Theater and Mr. Fahad Khan, who has dedicated his life to teach theatre to blind children and both of them believed purely in the idea that theatre can change lives.

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BEST PRACTICES

1. One of the major projects undertaken is listed below:

ENACTUS, or Entrepreneurial Action through Us, is an international not for profit organization that works with business leaders and university students across the globe to develop outreach projects that improve the quality of life of people in need. SSCBS has a long association with Enactus. Many projects have been implemented by SSCBS chapter of Enactus. Enactus SSCBS is currently running 5 projects Raahat, Khidki, Udaan, Avya, and Pravah. Sensitization towards Social Issues SSCBS takes all initiatives to make the student community an active agent of change in the process of development of the society.

2. One of the other major initiatives is the street play festival – MANTHAN organized by SSCBS wherein it joins hands with the street theatre societies of colleges across the globe. It is an effort to transform the mindset of the viewers with a belief that the power to do so lies within them. From its humble beginnings at the Jantar Mantar in 2007 with just three performances, it has today evolved into the largest street theatre festival in India with an International footprint. Manthan'18 was organized in 51 cities at 130 different locations in 21 states of India and to increase the gamut of the festival, the team has organized street play performances in 10 other countries (Canada, Panama, Czech Republic, Afghanistan, Kenya, Nigeria, Bangladesh, Zambia, and Nepal).

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FUTURE PLAN OF ACTION

- 1. To enhance efforts towards extension activities by continuing to support social entrepreneurship and inclusive development.
- 2. To provide strong all round support to the students by strengthening the mentor ship program and providing professional counseling services for the college family.
- 3. To continue to make efforts to keep the course curriculum current and topical.
- 4. To identify and provide support to students who need more in-depth attention and learning guidance.
- 5. To continue to offer relevant value add courses to strengthen the academic capabilities of the students.
- 6. To grow our global worldview by providing opportunities such as international conferences /symposia / FDPs.
- 7. To broaden the research capabilities of the college fraternity by providing research based platforms such as a college journal.
- 8. To continue to provide more growth opportunities to the students of the college by engaging more actively with our recruitment partners for driving curriculum changes and personality enhancement support.
