6. Playing of Holi and / or carrying of color / gugal shall be considered as **VIOLATION OF DISCIPLINE** and disciplinary action under the provision of University Ordinances shall be taken.

GUIDELINES

1. All are requested to desist from playing Holi in a rowdy manner, and/or with wet colours/balloons/pistons inside the premise of Educational Institution. Entry to Colleges/Departments/ Centres/Halls/Hostels would be regulated through Identity Cards during the festival days.
2. The Principals, Head of the Departments and Provost of Halls/Hostels may form Committees of teachers, students and karamcharis to prevent the entry of outsiders into the Colleges and Departments. Security Guards should be posted at the gates to check the Identity Cards of all visitors & students.
3. All anti-ragging and anti-eve-teasing provisions would be made applicable in case of harassment caused to any student during the period.
4. All the Principals, Dean of Faculties, Head of the Departments and Provosts of Halls/Hostels should be available to take care of any untoward incidence. In case they have to go out of their respective Institution, a senior person should be deputed to be present during his/her absence in the premises of the Institution.
5. The University has been assured full cooperation by the Police authorities in maintaining law and order and strict action against eve-teasing. For this purpose police force is being deployed at various strategic positions around the Colleges. Mobile patrolling is also being deployed. The University has requested the Police authorities to deploy force in uniform and in plain clothes in the buses going to various colleges.
6. The police has been requested to intensify patrolling outside Institutes/Colleges/ Hostels/ Halls.
7. The University has approached the DTC and Metro authorities to check any harassment of girl students in the buses and Metro especially during 'Holi' week. DTC drivers have been instructed to take the buses to the nearest Police Station in case any hooliganism or harassment of students is noticed in their buses, especially any incident targeted at girls.
8. On any attempt to create mischief in a bus or to divert a bus towards a girl college/campus, the bus would be taken to the nearest Police Station with a view to preventing mischief and penalizing the offenders.
9. Student volunteers will also assist the authorities in maintaining law & order, and discipline in the buses.
10. The University would request cooperation from MEDIA viz. PRESS, RADIO and TV – to give wide publicity to curb the menace of Hooliganism.
11. Special check on entry of guests in the hostels/Halls during these days be enforced in order to prevent entry of unwanted outsiders.
12. A Control Room, North & South Campus jointly manned by Delhi Police and DTC authorities and the University Officials at **Room No. – 10, Proctor's office, 1st Floor, Conference Centre, University of Delhi, Delhi-7** and office of the Deputy Dean Students' Welfare, South Campus, University of Delhi would function to deal with any untoward incident. **Telephone Numbers of JOINT CONTROL ROOM are 27667291 (North) campus, 24119832 (South Campus)**. It is, therefore, requested that Principals, Head of Departments and Provost of Halls/Hostels, disseminate information to students, teachers and staff about the location and functioning of the Joint Control Room.
13. The law and order authorities have also been requested to make adequate arrangements outside the Colleges and nearby bus stops where the classes for the Non-Collegiate and Correspondence Courses students are held.
