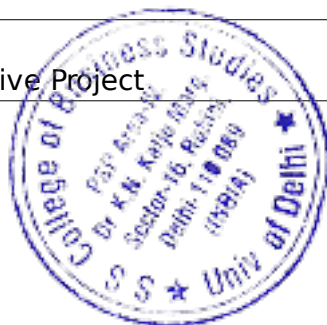

It was a very full two days when more than 1,700 students, alumni, faculty members and business leaders met at the Taj Land's End in Mumbai on 21-22 July to celebrate the incredible impact Enactus India has made across the country this year. ## INDIA SHINES AT 2018 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

The Enactus World Cup 2018 held at San Jose in October 2018 saw the participation of 37 National Champion teams with over 3000 students, academic advisors and business leaders in attendance. Shri Ram College of Commerce, India's champion team made it to the final four and won the 3rd place!
