# Feedback Analysis of Students, Parents, Teachers, Alumni and Recruiters (2018-19)

## Students' Feedback Analysis

The college has conducted feedback survey in the month of April 2019. Overall 90% or more students agreed that the administration is putting efforts for the development of the institution.

According to the survey, more than 83% of students believed that a course is suitable to the industry requirements and taught with a focus on practical application and critical thinking in the classes. More than 79% of them felt that sufficient number of optional papers are offered in the programme. As per 86% of them, it has generated the interest of students in different subjects.

Approximately 70% of students stated that the University has adopted effective admission process and attracted meritorious students. 83% or more of them are of the opinion that latest teaching aids and student centred learning resources are available in the University. 70% or more of them believed that teachers are encouraged to undertake research activities as well as participate or organise seminars/workshops/symposium. As per 76% of them, there is effective system of examination and evaluation being followed by the University.

More than 70% of students feel that sufficient infrastructure is available in the college for curricular and co-curricular activities.

As many as 86% of them feel that MOUs enhance the scope of mutual cooperation with reputed institutions and research organisations. 95% or more students are satisfied with initiatives taken up to ensure improvement in quality during the last academic year. Atleast 97% of them believe that IQAC is working well for promoting quality in the institution.

A request regarding introduction of skill development and job oriented courses was made. Students suggested that greater exposure to real life scenarios should be given so that area of interest and actual potential can be identified in an effective manner.

### Parents' Feedback Analysis

The college has conducted feedback survey in the month of April 2019. Overall the parents are satisfied with learning process followed in the institution.

According to the survey, 84% or more of the parents felt that the syllabus of current programmes is appropriate and its content is relevant to latest/future technologies. Students are encouraged to participate in several academic forums.

85% of them are satisfied with the system adopted to monitor the students' progress and credentials of teachers. All of these helped in gaining knowledge about real life scenarios as well as personality development as per 90% of them.

They suggested that more efforts needs to be made by college to ensure overall development of students.

85% of them are satisfied with the infrastructure and learning resources such as library, internet, computers etc. The college provided decent quality of placement and administrative support during the year.

Approximately 95% of them believed that discipline is fairly maintained in the college but it needs to be strengthened in the upcoming years.

### **Teachers' Feedback Analysis**

The college has conducted feedback survey in the month of April 2019. Overall, 90% or more of teachers are satisfied with the efforts made for development of the institution.

According to the survey, more than 80% of teachers believed that the appropriate syllabus, reference material and balanced proportion of theory and application is given in the course.

Approximately 80% of them felt that the course offered sufficient number of optional papers and generated the interest of students in different subjects.

All the teachers adopted new techniques and strategies such as seminar presentation, group discussion etc. to enhance the effectiveness of teaching process.

There is sufficient infrastructure including prescribed books and teaching aids available in the college for curricular and co-curricular activities.

Approximately 70% of them felt encouraged to carry out research activities as well as participate or organise seminars, workshops, conferences. The fact that encouragement is given to establish industry linkages and provide consultancy services is well recognised by teachers.

A suggestion that the level of knowledge and awareness about latest developments should be enhanced by teachers was put forth. 70% of them stated that an effective system of examination and evaluation is followed in the University.

## **Alumni's Feedback Analysis**

Feedback from alumni was taken through Google forms. Also informal feedback was taken from them as and when they visited college. All most all the Alumni suggested to introduce more contemporary add on courses like Data Analytics, Digital Marketing and Entrepreneurship etc. It was also suggested that college should encourage a greater level of interaction by inviting them for special lectures.
