

## **Feedback Analysis of Students, Parents, Teachers, Alumni and Recruiters (2020-21)**

### **STUDENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**

The college has conducted feedback survey in the month of June 2021.

According to the survey, more than 80% of students are satisfied with the coverage of syllabus, focus on practical application, critical thinking, and usage of student centric methods in the classes.

Approximately 83% of them believed that opportunities, recognition and academic cum administrative support are thoroughly provided to gain exposure to extra-curricular activities. They accepted that moderate to great level of efforts is made to inculcate soft and employability skills.

80% or more of them believed that the placement opportunities and career counselling are provided in the campus. Further, diverse set of companies have visited the campus and offered variety of profiles to students.

More than 90% of them felt that sufficient infrastructure is available in the college for curricular and co-curricular activities. 88% or more of them recognized that teaching and mentoring process resulted in their cognitive, social, and emotional growth.

82% or more of students believed that efforts are made to engage them in the monitoring, review, and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process. 86% or more stated that the college has made praiseworthy contribution in inculcating moral values and making them responsible citizens.

Several concerns were raised by students during pandemic. There was disruption in teaching due to suspension of physical classes, difficulty faced in internal assessments, limited availability of study material and mental agony faced by them. The interruption in placement process and summer internship opportunities was also reported. The college remained proactive and took couple of initiatives to resolve these issues despite the hiring freeze.

### **PARENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**

The college has conducted feedback survey in the month of June 2021. Overall, more than 83% of parents felt that value-based education is provided in the institution.

According to the survey, 92% or more parents felt that the overall syllabus is appropriate, and its content is relevant to latest/future technologies.

90% of them found that encouragement is being given to students to participate in academic forums. The college has got qualified teaching staff and adopted decent system to monitor the students' progress.

Several learning resources such as library, internet, computers etc. along with placement and administrative support are easily accessible as per 90% or more parents.

Approximately 87% of them believed that disciplinary environment is being maintained in the college. The college provided high degree of support towards teaching and mentoring of

ward during lockdown. They also appreciated the efforts made for holistic development of students and reiterated that such efforts should continue in future.

### **TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**

The college has conducted feedback survey in the month of June 2021. Overall, the administration along with IQAC is putting great number of efforts for the development of the institution.

According to the survey, all the teachers believed that overall contents as well as mix of theory and practical application are appropriately suggested in the curriculum. As per 87% or more of them, decent number of optional papers are offered to students which also helps in generating students' interest in different subjects.

All of them stated that new techniques and strategies such as seminar presentation, group discussion etc. are used to enhance the effectiveness of teaching process. During Covid -19, they requested that resources needed in teaching and research activities to be made available in online mode.

They praised the efforts made to provide soft and hard copies of books, journals, databases as well as teaching aids especially during lockdown.

More than 97% of them felt that recognition and administrative support gave them motivation to carry out research activities as well as participate or organize seminars, workshops, conferences. They felt encouraged in providing consultancy services and establishing linkages with industry.

Such efforts should be continued for raising the level of knowledge among teachers in future. Around 75% of them are satisfied with the system of examination and evaluation being followed in the University.

### **ALUMNIS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**

Feedback from alumni was taken through Google forms. Also, informal feedback was taken from them as and when they visited college.

During their academic tenure at college, more than 90% of the alumni believed that the curriculum enhanced critical thinking and problem-solving skills and also helped them in their corporate life.

Most of the Alumni suggested to introduce contemporary add on courses like Digital Marketing, Entrepreneurship etc. It was also suggested that college should encourage a greater level of interaction/involvement of alumni for the benefit of the students. They were forthcoming in helping college in terms of mentoring students, workshops, seminars placements etc.

### **RECRUITERS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS**

It was suggested by the recruiters that students did a thorough research of the profile and role that is being offered to them. Also, they focused more upon online certification courses to be pursued by the students in order to enhance their core knowledge of the subject.

Recommendations for the students sitting for placements:

- Students must work on relevant projects, take up internships of short duration and spend time on increasing their knowledge base in the field of their interest, to become more industry ready as well as excel in their career.

- Considering finance and investment banking, students must pursue CFA and other courses in fintech.
- Training in resume building and presenting and communication skills is required.
