

Feedback Analysis of Students, Parents, Teachers, Alumni and Recruiters (2022-23) STUDENTS'

Students feedback Analysis 2022-23

The college conducted Students feedback survey in the month of June 2023.

Analysis shows that approximately 75% of students are satisfied with the coverage of syllabus, focus on practical application, critical thinking, and usage of student centric methods in the class room.

Approximately 86% of them believed that opportunities, recognition and academic cum administrative support are thoroughly provided to gain exposure to extra-curricular activities. They accepted that moderate to great level of efforts is made to inculcate soft and employability skills.

More than 91% believed that the placement opportunities and career counselling provided in the campus is relevant and important. They agree that diverse set of companies visit the campus and variety of profiles offered to them.

More than 90% of them are satisfied with infrastructure available in the college for curricular and co-curricular activities. More than 97% of the students were of the opinion that the campus is hygienic and clean. 85% or more of them recognized that teaching and mentoring process resulted in their cognitive, social, and emotional growth.

95% of the students were satisfied with the library facilities of the college.

More than 88% of the students believed that are involved in the monitoring, review, and continuous quality improvement of teaching learning process. Approximately 91% agree that the college has a culture of inculcating moral values and making them a responsible citizen.

Students are satisfied with the evaluation in internal assessments and study material provided to the them. Students agree that college is proactive and makes efforts to resolve any issue faced by the students.

PARENTS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2022-23

The college conducted feedback survey in the month of June 2023. Analysis shows that more than 86% of parents felt that the value-based education is provided in the institution. More than 90% of the parents felt that the overall syllabus is appropriate, and its contents are relevant to latest industry trends/technologies. Parents agree that teaching staff well qualified and encourages the students to participate in academic forums. adopted decent system to monitor the students' progress.

More than 90% of the parents are satisfied with the learning resources such as library, internet, computers etc. and believe that they are easily accessible to the students. are as per

90% of parents are satisfied with the placement and administrative support provided by the college. They suggested that more efforts should be made by the college for is overall personality development of their wards

Approximately 93% of them believed that disciplinary environment is being maintained in the college. The college provided high degree of support towards teaching and mentoring of ward. They also appreciated the efforts made for holistic development of students and reiterated that such efforts should continue in future.

TEACHERS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2022-23

The college conducted feedback survey in the month of June 2023.

Analysis shows that all the teachers were satisfied with the overall contents of the syllabus and the mix of theory and practical application in the curriculum. As per survey more than 90% of teachers believe that decent number of optional papers are offered to students giving them enough exposure to generate students' interest in different subjects.

All of them agree that new techniques and strategies such as presentations, group discussion, case studies etc. are used to enhance the effectiveness of teaching process.

All the teachers have appreciated the availability of the teaching aids like soft and hard copies of books, journals, databases etc.

More than 90% of them felt that administrative support motivates them to carry out research activities, participate or organize seminars, workshops and conferences. They felt encouraged in providing consultancy services and establishing linkages with industry.

Such efforts should be continued for raising the level of knowledge among teachers in future.

Approximately 20% of them felt some method of merit recognition not only for research but for teaching and other administrative work should be there. Around 81% of them are satisfied with the system of examination and evaluation being followed in the University.

ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2022-23

Feedback from alumni was collected through Google forms. Also, informal feedback was taken from them as and when they visited college.

More than 93% of the alumni believed that the curriculum enhanced critical thinking and problem-solving skills and also helped them in their corporate life.

Most of the Alumni appreciated the skill development and value-added courses offered to the students. However, they suggested to introduce more contemporary add on courses like Technology & Operations Management, Entrepreneurship etc. It was also suggested that college should encourage a greater level of interaction of alumni for the benefit of the students. They were forthcoming in helping college in terms of mentoring students, workshops, seminars, placements etc.

RECRUITERS' FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2022-23

The recruiters appreciated that students did a thorough research of the profile and role that was being offered to them. However, the students should put more efforts for doing the same. They suggested that the students should focus more on pursuing online certification courses in order to enhance their knowledge and skill enhancement.

RECRUITERS' Recommendations for the students appearing for the placements:

- Students must work on relevant projects, take up internships of short duration and spend time on increasing their knowledge base in the field of their interest, to become more industry ready as well as excel in their career.
- Considering finance and investment banking, students must pursue CFA and other courses in fintech and all students should have some knowledge of taxation.
- Training in resume building, advanced excel and presentation skills is required.
- Students must have the skills of Data Visualisation as it is quite in use these days for Data Analysis and Management. Apart from the technical skills students must be trained in soft skills as well.
