



COURSE DISTRIBUTION






How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?




How well is the level of focus given on practical aspects/applications of subject matter in the course content?






How well does the curriculum enhance critical thinking and problem solving?





How well does the curriculum develop subject specific skills?











Level of opportunities provided for exposure to extra-curricular activities.






Level of Encouragement/recognition/rewards given for extra-curricular activities





Level of administrative/academic support given to students to get involved in co-curricular activities








Diversity and quantity of books available in the library






Seating capacity in the library








