As the college's editorial board, we design and publish the annual college magazine, *Quadrangle*, that captures the memories of the years that went by and features the creative pieces, achievements and culture of our college. We also maintain a society blog that features articles, poems, book reviews, stories and op-eds by 50+ students across the country.

KEY ACTIVITIES

- 1. IIC Session with Mr. Siddharth Rathore- 2nd December, 2022 The society conducted a seminar in collaboration with IIC Yuva with Mr. Siddharth Rathore, Assistant Professor (Economics Department) at Gargi College, who enlightened us with regards to UPSC examinations as well as entrepreneurship. 50+ UPSC aspirants and budding entrepreneurs joined the session.
- **2. Author Session with Mr. Saksham Garg- 20th February, 2023** We also organized an interactive author session with Mr. Saksham Garg, author of National Bestseller

- 'SAMSARA' and editor at Penguin Random House India. 40+ literary and publication enthusiasts attended the seminar.
- **3. Author Session with Mr. Vipin Thapliyal- 18th April, 2023** We hosted another author session with Mr. Vipin Thapliyal, author of 'The Nine Angels' as the speaker. 50+ literature enthusiasts joined us for the seminar and had the opportunity to interact with Mr. Thapliyal.
- **4. Author Session with Ms. Aditi Vats- 19th April, 2023** An interactive author session with Ms. Aditi Vats, poetess and author of the poetry compilation 'Kavya Mahabharata', was held by the society, where 50+ poetry and literary aficionados participated eagerly.
- 5. Magazine: Quadrangle 22 We are all set to publish and distribute the annual college magazine and yearbook: Quadrangle'22 by the end of June. The magazine will showcase the literary pieces of our college students and their various accomplishments and will feature the students, faculty members, societies in the yearbook. We've also planned and executed the society, class, and faculty photographs whilst collaborating with Darkroom for publishing the same in the subsequent magazine.
- **6. The Blog** The blog (www.litsocsscbs.com) showcases the literary works, reviews, articles, opinion pieces, and editorials of 50+ aspiring writers, poets, and dramatists from colleges across the country. We provide a platform for students across colleges and schools to express their opinions and share their knowledge with the rest of the world.
- 7. Social Media Our social media presence spans Instagram, Facebook, LinkedIn and Twitter account and are working actively to increase its presence. We have gained over 1400+ followers on Instagram, with an average of 24.8k+ monthly accounts reached. Our LinkedIn page has a follower base of 140+ students and professionals. We recently created a Twitter account to build a community of literary enthusiasts, and creatives and have engaged with notable authors like Manu S.Pillai and Chitra Divakaruni (author of The Palace of Illusions).
- **8. Live Project with SAMSARA** We have also completed a successful live project with Saksham Garg, the author of the bestselling novel 'SAMSARA'. A team of 6-8 members of LitSoc dedicated a month on this project which focused on the marketing and networking aspect of publications.

- 1. LitGala, December 02, 2022: LitGala'22 was organized as a winter fest to welcome the first year students and provide them a chance to get to know about Litsoc and showcase their talents. The event consisted of a speaker session on the topic of Entrepreneurship, an open mic, an Exhibition, writing competition and Book stall.
- 2. **Bibliotheca** April 18-19, 2023: Bibliotheca'23 called upon 400+ hidden poets, creative storytellers, dramatic poets, writers, and literary enthusiasts from colleges across the country to display their talents, compete for prizes and even splurge on books, at one of the most prominent literary events in the DU circuit. The event witnessed a footfall of over 500 students from colleges across the city.
