Thesis Abstract: In this study, we propose a new measure of diversification based on the correlation between group firms' sales. Thereafter, we suggest a new dimension to the existing literature by expanding related diversification into positively related diversification and negatively related diversification. Then, we apply panel data analysis on 10 years' data (2007 to 2016) of 1417 non-financial Indian listed firms to measure the impact of all types of diversification (Total diversification, unrelated diversification, related diversification, positively related diversification, and negatively related diversification) on all three aspects of firm's performance measures i.e. risk, return, and risk-adjusted return. We find a positive impact of negative related, related, and total diversification on a firm's risk, return, and risk-adjusted return. Further, the present study strongly suggests the superiority of negatively related diversification strategy over others (based on results reported in the thesis).

Research Projects

Financial Literacy amongst Indian youth: University of Delhi Innovation Project

[2017]

This project aimed at measuring the Financial Literacy of urban youth in India based on the definition and research instrument developed by the OECD. The study covered 1500 DU students from various colleges belonging to Science, Arts & Commerce disciplines. The results indicated low financial literacy of students across all categories with boys scoring higher than girls. Also, commerce students had the highest literacy scores followed by Science & Arts students. Based on the areas identified as per the questionnaire, remedial measures such as vocational courses, and refresher classes were recommended.

Predicting the Financial Crisis of The Companies Based Upon Cash Flows Statements: University of Delhi Innovation Project [2015]

This project attempts to improve the use of traditional ratios analysis by taking into account ratios from cash flow statements to address the problem of window dressing and false corporate reporting. In this project, several new ratios were developed and used to build afinancial model for predicting the bankruptcy of corporations 1-3 years ahead. By studying a total of 101 US companies in the manufacturing sector, the model yielded an 82.2% overall accuracy. This model was then tested for two and one year before bankruptcy and was able to classify 85.18% and 93.87% of bankrupt companies correctly.
