

Annual Report on Elumiere'24

The Annual Economics Conclave, Elumiere'24, is the annual event organised by the Economics Society of SSCBS, Ecovision. This year, the event was held on the 18th of March. The event saw three flagship events: Enigma - The Case Study Competition, The Long Sho(r)t - The Stock Market Simulation, and Coals and Clues - The Simulation Challenge. It was conducted in an offline format and saw an overwhelming participation of 1700+ teams from several prestigious institutions such as ISB, SRCC, IIM Rohtak, IIM Indore, IIM Lucknow, Hindu College and Hansraj College. The event secured partnerships from companies like Unacademy, Stock Edge, KK Securities Ltd, Jaipuria - Institute of Management and several more, and prizes worth a total of Rs. 45,000 were given.

A panel of judges was invited to preside over Enigma - The Flagship Case Study.

Organized annually by Ecovision as part of Elumiere'24, Enigma is a renowned case study competition designed to evaluate and hone the analytical and presentation skills of aspiring business leaders. Participants engage in a multi-stage process that emphasizes a thorough understanding of complex business challenges. The preliminary round requires participants to analyze a carefully crafted problem statement, identifying its key elements and underlying complexities

Those who successfully navigate the initial analysis phase progress to the final round. Here, participants must present their proposed solutions to a panel of experts in a clear, concise, and persuasive manner. This round assesses a candidate's ability to effectively communicate their findings and recommendations, a crucial skill for success in the business world. By combining a rigorous analysis phase with a demanding presentation component, Enigma offers a comprehensive evaluation of a participant's business acumen.



Our Flagship Mock Stock competition, The Long Sho(r)t, was organized wherein the participants were required to use their prevailing knowledge of the Stock Market to strategise and maximize their profits. The competition witnessed over 450 participants, who competed in the prelims, and a total of twenty teams made it into the final round after rigorous efforts and show of skills.

In the prelims, the participants were made to trade in a real-life stock market environment, that saw a demand and supply based model for determining the prices. In the final round, the participants had to rigorously study different industries on the basis of the information provided, which involved multiple metrics, and choose a corpus. This corpus was eventually used by the finalists in multiple trading rounds and an auction for tokens. After the commencement of the finals, the winners were awarded with prizes worth ₹15,000.



In 'Coals and Clues,' participants were thrust into a world of intrigue and peril, tasked with navigating the treacherous waters of power and ambition. As they schemed and strategized, they had to carefully weigh their options, balancing the allure of dark magic with the necessity of righteous leadership. Only those with cunning, resourcefulness, and a keen sense of justice emerged victorious, shaping the fate of the kingdom for generations to come.

Tasked with embodying the role of a necromancer, participants remained on edge, constantly considering competitors' strategies before devising their own, all in a bid to raise an unstoppable army of the undead through the forbidden arts of necromancy. Through auctions and daring raids, they gathered their forces, plotting to overthrow the oppressive regime and claim the kingdom for themselves.
