2. Information about the society in brief (3-4 lines):

Established in January 2009, Enactus at Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies (SSCBS) was started as an attempt to reach out to people in need, based on principles of entrepreneurship and philanthropy. Following the 17 Sustainable Goals of the UN, we have successfully run 9 projects. With a three-fold objective of economic, social and environmental betterment, the team believes in its power to be the change the world needs. Enactus SSCBS has successfully received grants from Dell, Ford Motors, KPMG, Coca Cola etc. It won the World Cup 2017 for Project Raahat and Project Udaan. Project Basera launched in 2020 has also come under Top 12 out of 174 Enactus projects across 23 countries in Race for Climate Action, and under Top 48 for both 1 Race 4 Oceans and Race to Rethink Plastic out of 174 Enactus Projects across 23 countries.

3. Summary of work done throughout the year 2020-21 (4-5 lines):

Project Pravaah was launched in 2019 for which expansion is going on in 2020-2021 with the increase in sales of air purifier and stubble pots and e-listing of stubble pots by further delving into vertical gardening and stubble manure. We are also inculcating backward integration of farmers through sensitization sessions and helping them form SHGs and increasing the reach of the project by increasing the production centres and getting into various governmental and private partnerships. Project Basera was launched in 2020 with the aim to upgrade homeless shelters and holistic development of its people by providing employment through production and sale of Yoga mats from PPE scrap with further diversification in PPE bags, and in cardboard furniture products like lap tables, stools etc. Surveys, RWA Visits and sensitisation programs have been conducted for both the projects throughout the year.

3. **Kaiterra-** Air Quality Experts: Kaiterra is an internationally reputed organization that sells air quality monitors across the world. As a part of its CSR initiative, it gives us technical guidance about the product and monitoring the air quality.

11. Any other information:

Project Basera has been launched in 2020 which focuses on upgradation of homeless shelters and holistic development of its people by providing employment to them, thereby bringing sustainable solutions and fostering desired patterns of behaviour. The women at these homeless shelters make Yoga Mats, handbags, mattresses, etc by upcycling unused PPE scrap out of which 30 yoga mats have been sold. The project has further been expanding into products made out of waste corrugated boxes with the aim to curb cardboard pollution. Project Pravaah was launched in 2019 to deal with stubble burning and curb air pollution. The project provides holistic indoor air purification solutions to a highly untapped sizable market while reducing harmful effects of stubble burning by pseudo-in-situ tech and innovative entrepreneurial efforts while also sensitizing and integrating the backward farmer

communities. We have found a perfect solution for stubble burning by creating stubble pots. Our other offering, i.e., Pravaah's air purifier provides the middle class sections of the country a 65 percent more affordable solution to the unnoticed but grave issue of indoor air pollution.
