## 2. Information about the society in brief (3-4 lines):

Established in January 2009, Enactus at Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies (SSCBS) was started as an attempt to reach out to individuals in need, based on principles of entrepreneurship and philanthropy. Following the 17 Sustainable Goals of the UN, we have successfully run 9 projects and impacted more than 7 lakh lives. With a three-fold objective of economic, social and environmental betterment, the team believes in its power to be the change the world needs. Enactus SSCBS has successfully received grants from Dell, Ford Motors, KPMG, Coca Cola etc. It won the World Cup 2017 for Project Raahat and Project Udaan. Project Pravaah has also come under Top 48 out of 174 Enactus projects across 23 countries in Race for Climate Action and Basera has come under Top 48 for both 1 Race 4 Oceans and Race to Rethink Plastic out of 174 Enactus Projects across 23 countries.

## 3. Summary of work done throughout the year 2021-22

Project Pravaah which was launched in 2019 is undergoing expansion. We worked on changing body of Pravaah purifier for which we made prototypes with multiple materials. We introduced new sizes of Pravaah stubble pots in 4-inch and have found partner for continuous supply of our product. Further we conducted sessions to sensitize school children about air pollution as well as inform them about small measures to control indoor pollution. We're working on inter-state and intra-state expansion of the project too.

Project Basera which was launched in 2020 has already expanded to another community based in Connaught Place. We have conducted a need assessment there and are working on empowerment of our community there. The women there currently face much lesser problems in comparison to when we started working there. The women currently are learning stitching, self defense, menstrual hygiene, microfinance management and much more.
