1. Vivanté

VIVANTÉ is the Annual Philanthropic Fest of SSCBS. It was held from 9th to 11th March this year. The event aims at encouraging positivity and good health among students and faculty members. 3. Shaheed Diwas

To remember the martyrdom of our national heroes Shri Sukhdev Thapar, Shri Shivram Rajguru and Shri Bhagat Singh, many activities were conducted. A flower dedication i.e. phool samarpan ceremony was organised to pay our respects to the brave heroes. Everyone gathered around the statue of Shri Shaheed Sukhdev, located in the College campus and flower garlands were put around his neck by the respected principal mam, some faculty members and the NSS team. We also paid tribute to the freedom fighters by planting trees on the campus of Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies. The trees would help preserve the country they shed their lives for. We planted a total of 9 plants which included fruit trees such as pomegranate, anjeer(fig), flower bearing trees such as night jasmine, kachnar and trees with long life such as kalpvriksh. As a tribute to the three martyrs who sacrificed their lives fighting the battle for India's independence, a candle lighting ceremony was organised. The ceremony began with a candle being lit in front of the photographs of Shaheed Bhagat Singh, Shaheed Sukhdev Thapar and Shaheed Shivram Rajguru by respected Principal ma'am, followed by all the teachers and then the students. By lighting the candles, everyone paid their respect to the three bravehearts and pledged to make India a nation the martyrs had dreamt of.
