Key Achievements in 2023-24

Donation Drives

NSS SSCBS continually strives to bring light into the lives of underprivileged sections of society who require assistance. Thus, it organizes donation drives each year, making a positive difference in many people's lives.

This year, NSS SSCBS, in collaboration with Kartavya- The Social Service Forum of SSCBS, conducted a clothes donation drive during the Annual Philanthropic Fest Vivante'23 to give old clothes an opportunity to be reused and a textbook donation drive to cultivate a sense of cooperation within our community. We also conducted a food donation drive to collect food items for the elderly residents of Davo - an old age home. NSS volunteers set up a collection point near the college ground and encouraged students, faculty, and staff to donate non-perishable food items such as rice, flour, lentils, pasta, salt, and cooking oil.

NSS feels that there is no better exercise for the heart than reaching down and helping people up, thus they cordially invite everyone to come forward and donate as much as possible.

Cleanliness Drive

We conducted the SSCBS Cleanliness Drive at Japanese Park , Sector-10, Rohini, as part of the 'Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign'. The volunteers came together to make collective efforts to keep

our surroundings clean and pledged to regularly engage in activities related to cleanliness and sanitation.

Blood Donation Camp
