The members of the society have participated in 200+ competitions and stood on the podium in 45+ of them. Numerous wins and positions have been recorded in competitions held by prestigious institutions in the country including IIM Kozhikode, IIT Roorkee, IIT Madras, SRCC, DTU, Hansraj College and St. Stephens. This is a testimony to the proficiency of the society members in the various fields of finance and analytics.

The society's flagship event, The Analytics Conclave 2022 was held between the dates 19th June and 26th June 2022. It was a one of its kind Data Discovery Workshop which covered two enriching sessions on topics related to data science.

- Session 1: Demystifying AI: AI Thinking and Products of the Next Decade by Mr. Shailesh Kumar
- Session 2: How to Interpret AI Models for Business by Mr. Hitesh Hinduja

The event hosted 2 experienced Data Scientists from reputed companies over a period of four days. The speakers presented their insights on the Data Science industry, the applications of Machine Learning and AI in Fintech, Search Engines and Consulting among various other topics. The Conclave witnessed active participation of 1700+ students who benefitted from the insights shared by the speakers and the interactive discussions on various disruptions in the analytics industry.

Nucleus organised Viz-a-thon, a data visualisation competition on 18th April 2023 which received a participation of 194 individuals from reputed institutes such as SRCC and IIM Lucknow.

The Analytics Conclave 2023 commenced on 10th June 2023 with the first round of Epsilon - The Analytics Case Competition. Two speaker sessions are scheduled to be organised within a span of four days to provide the participants with exclusive industry insights. The final round of the competition is to be held online on 18th June 2023.

Other Initiatives:

- **Knowledge Sharing Sessions:** Nucleus, proudly being the only Analytics Society of the college, takes up KSS on various industry-standard applications encompassing MS Excel, Python, Power BI, Tableau, and Alteryx among multiple others. These KSS are unique in the college, given the fact that they are based on in-demand and industry-accepted Analytics Tools. Alteryx is one such unique software that was learned by members of Nucleus as a part of the society (considering its gaining recognition in the corporate world), compared to many other societies of the college.

- **Intra Soc Competitions:** After successfully learning each new software, the students are provided with a practical competition prepared by their peers to help them reinforce their technical skills and strengthen the application of important concepts involved in a particular software. This initiative by the society is also something that sets it apart from most of the societies in the college.
- **Live Projects:** The society also shares an excellent long standing relationship with the corporate sector and has collaborated with firms to take up live projects, conducted speaker sessions both within the private and public sector domains. In the past, we have worked with firms like Delhi International Airport, Coal India Ltd, EY, SBI, NeenoPal, etc. This year, we had newer partnerships with firms such as Seekho, EXL, KRG Consultants. These projects have significantly helped the students in gaining a practical experience of how Data Analytics is used in corporations and provided them a first hand experience by strengthening the knowledge of the Analytics Tools they have been provided with.
