English Pledge:

Hindi Pledge:

"हम, भारत के नागरिक, लोकतंत्र में अपनी पूर्ण आस्था रखते हुए यह शपथ लेते हैं कि हम अपने देश की लोकतांत्रिक परंपराओं की मर्यादा को बनाए रखेंगे तथा स्वतंत्र, निष्पक्ष एवं शांतिपूर्ण निर्वाचन की गरिमा को अक्षुण्ण रखते हुए, निर्भीक होकर, धर्म, वर्ग, जाति, समुदाय, भाषा अथवा अन्य किसी भी प्रलोभन से प्रभावित हुए बिना सभी निर्वाचन में अपने मताधिकार का प्रयोग करेंगे।"

Importance of the Voters' Pledge:

The Voters' Pledge is not just a symbolic act — it is a reminder of the strength that lies in each vote. By taking the pledge, the youth reaffirmed their **commitment to the nation's democratic values**, promising to vote without any bias or external influence.
