Enactus SSCBS conducted a field visit to Majnu Ka Tilla to assess the living conditions and challenges faced by the Pakistani Hindu refugee community residing there. The visit aimed to gather insights for an upcoming project focused on their empowerment through sustainable livelihood and social inclusion.

The team observed that the community lives in inadequate housing with limited access to sanitation, healthcare, education, and formal employment. Most residents lack legal documentation, making it difficult to access basic government services. Women showed interest in learning skills like tailoring and handicrafts, while the youth expressed a desire for digital and vocational training.

Children face barriers to education due to documentation and financial issues. The visit highlighted the need for interventions in livelihood generation, education support, legal aid, and health awareness, laying the foundation for a meaningful, community-driven empowerment initiative.
