Objective of the Event:

Prologue 2024 aimed to provide a creative platform for society members, particularly the organizing committee, to develop, rehearse, and stage original theatrical works. The event's objective was to celebrate **emerging talent**, encourage experimentation, and strengthen members' skills in production, direction, and performance.

Brief Summary:

Prologue, the annual theatre showcases by Fourth Wall Productions, marked its **9th edition in 2024**. This year's event was the culmination of a **month-long theatre workshop**, where the organizing committee worked with mentors to refine their craft in scriptwriting, character work, and ensemble staging.

The showcase featured **four diverse plays**:

1. **The Dumb Waiter** – A gripping piece exploring loyalty, suspense, and fate.
2. **Ambu and Rajlakshmi** – A heartfelt tale blending city life with the warmth of sisterhood and rediscovery.
3. **Ande ke Chhilke** – A social commentary contrasting outward shine with inner emptiness.
4. **It's Not You, It's Me** – A modern exploration of insecurities, lies, love, and heartbreak.

The event celebrated the hard work of first- and second-year members, offering them a stage to present **fresh perspectives and unique voices**. With its mix of genres and themes, Prologue 2024 reaffirmed its place as a **cornerstone event** in the society's calendar.

Key Outcomes / Learnings:

- Participants gained practical experience in directing, acting, and script development.
- The showcase encouraged **collaborative creation and peer-to-peer mentorship**.
