# Student Council Elections 2025 – Timeline & Process

The Student Council elections are an important step toward ensuring fair representation and student leadership within the college. The following schedule and eligibility requirements have been carefully laid out to provide clarity and transparency to all students. All candidates are expected to strictly follow the dates and procedures mentioned below.

#### **Election Timeline**

#### 1. Saturday, 13th September 2025

- The Nomination Form will be shared on email with all students.
- o Interested and eligible candidates must **fill the form carefully** and **submit it via email** to **councilelection@sscbs.du.ac.in** before the deadline.

## 2. Monday, 15th September 2025 (Deadline: 9:00 PM)

- o This marks the last date and time for submission of Nomination Forms.
- All forms must be submitted to the official election email ID
  (councilelection@sscbs.du.ac.in) before 9:00 PM. Submissions received after the
  deadline will not be considered.

## 3. Tuesday, 16th September 2025 (End of Day)

- o The withdrawal window for candidatures will close.
- Any candidate wishing to step back from the election must submit their withdrawal request before this deadline.
- After this stage, the final candidate list will be prepared and announced.

### 4. Wednesday, 17th September 2025

- The List of Eligible candidates/contestants and voters will be published by 6:00pm
- This list will serve as the final voter roll, and all students are requested to verify their details once it is released.

### 5. Monday, 22nd September 2025 - Election Day

- 3:00 PM onwards Candidate speeches and presentations will take place in person, giving each candidate the opportunity to present their vision before the student body.
- 4:15 PM onwards The official voting process will be conducted online in the computer lab (as like previous year election).
- All eligible students will be casting their vote through computer by participating in person at the time of voting. Each student will be allowed to cast only one vote. No remote or proxy voting. Voting right is non-transferable.
- Once the voting window closes, results will be tabulated digitally, and the final results will be declared the same day.

# **Eligibility Criteria for Contesting Candidates**

To ensure that the Student Council is represented by responsible, capable, and disciplined individuals, the following eligibility requirements must be met by any student wishing to contest:

- Candidate can file nomination for only one position.
- Candidates must have a minimum average of 66.67% Attendance up until last Semester.
- Candidates must hold a recognized Position of Responsibility (POR) of any recognised Society or be serving as a Class Representative (CR).
- Candidates must have no record of disciplinary action during their time at the college.
- It is mandatory for all candidates to **carefully go through the Student Council Constitution** before filing their nomination.
- Candidates are expected to **familiarize themselves with all the rules**, **processes**, **and guidelines** governing the elections. Ignorance of the rules will not be accepted as a justification for any lapse.
- For any doubts, clarifications, or queries, candidates are encouraged to contact the Election Committee at **councilelection@sscbs.du.ac.in** well before the deadlines.
- In any case of dispute on any matter, decision of Election officer will be final beyond the challenge.
