3. Other Initiatives

This event organized on 16 and 17 April hosted over 170 students with Rs. 15000+ in revenue.

• Zorbing :

An adventurous game where you roll down inside a giant transparent ball. This event filled with laughter as gravity takes you on a wild ride was organized on 16 and 17 April witnessed participation of 150+ students and generated revenue of more than Rs. 12000.
