In 2024–25, EcoClub SSCBS advanced its mission of sustainability through engaging events and strong student involvement. The Independence Day Brain Buster Quiz challenged students on environmental issues, general awareness, and current ecological trends. Additionally, a Road Safety & First Responder Workshop, held in	Prakriti, the annual environmental festival organized by the Eco Club of Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies, reflected a strong dedication to sustainability and innovative thinking. The fest featured three key events: the Ecological 2.0 Case Competition, the EcoSankalp 2.0 B-Plan Competition, and the Planet Pioneers Quiz. Each event

- 2. Waste Segregation Challenge: During Vitti 2024, EcoClub SSCBS hosted the Waste Segregation Challenge—a fun, hands-on activity that taught students the importance of sorting waste the right way. From classifying items to reflecting on real-world impacts,

the event sparked curiosity, teamwork, and a shared sense of responsibility for the environment across the campus.

- 3. Brain Busters Quiz: To celebrate Independence Day, EcoClub SSCBS hosted the online Brain Buster Quiz in collaboration with CDF, drawing over 100 enthusiastic participants. The quiz blended patriotic spirit with environmental awareness through fun, fast-paced questions. It sparked curiosity, learning, and camaraderie while making the celebration both meaningful and intellectually engaging for all.
- 4. E-Waste Collection Drive EcoClub SSCBS, together with Global Shapers, held an E-Waste Collection Drive on 3rd–4th March 2025 beside Eklavya Boys Hostel. The drive gave students a chance to drop off old or unused electronic items while also learning why safe disposal of e-waste matters. With enthusiastic participation, the team managed to collect over 50 different types of e-waste. More than just a collection effort, the event sparked conversations on sustainability and reminded students how small actions can make a big difference for the environment.
