Minutes of the Budget Allocation Committee for Students' Societies 2025-26

The meetings of the Budget Committee were held in the college at 12:15 p.m. on Friday, 29th August 2025, and at 12:45 p.m. on Tuesday, 9th September 2025.

The Committee discussed and finalized the budget allocation for the year. The following points were noted:

1. The budget allocation was made assuming a collection of Rs. 80 Lakhs (Approx.) under the College Student Welfare Fund.
2. The allocation was based on the budget proposals submitted by the Teacher-in-Charges (TICs) of the respective societies. The following factors were taken into consideration: Allocation made in the previous year, Amount utilized in the previous year, Budget requested for the current year, and Annual Performance Report (APR) points
3. For the present allocation, only those societies whose documents were in order were considered. Societies whose documentation is incomplete are required to submit the necessary documents at the earliest, after which allocations will be made for them.
4. Budget allocations were also made for the following heads: Student's Financial Assistance, Alumni activities, Convergence (Annual Business Seminar), Career Development Cell (CDC), and Student's Mentorship.
5. The student's societies/chapters are required to follow the GFR rules for disbursement/expenditures undertaken for activities. They are also required to follow the guidelines for spending of society funds.

The above recommendations are hereby submitted for approval.

It may be noted that, in the meeting held on 9th September 2025, allocations had already been made to societies whose documentation was complete as of that date (minutes attached). The agenda of the present meeting was to discuss the budget allocation for the remaining students' societies. After due deliberation, the following points were noted and recommended:

1. The allocation was based on the budget proposals submitted by the Teacher-in-Charges (TICs) of the respective societies. The following factors were taken into consideration: Allocation made in the previous year, Amount utilized in the previous year, Budget requested for the current year, and Annual Performance Report (APR) points
2. Allocations were made only to societies whose documentation was complete. Societies with pending requirements are required to submit the necessary documents at the earliest, following which their allocations will be finalized.
3. The students' societies/chapters are required to strictly follow the **GFR rules** for disbursement and expenditures undertaken for activities. They are also required to adhere to the **guidelines for spending of society funds**.
4. All events held after 29th September 2025, or from the date on which the society's documentation was completed in full, shall be eligible for organization and budgeting.

The above recommendations are hereby submitted for approval.

1. The allocation was based on the budget proposals submitted by the Teacher-in-Charges (TICs) of the respective societies. The following factors were taken into consideration: Allocation made in the previous year, Amount utilized in the previous year, Budget requested for the current year, and Annual Performance Report (APR) points
2. Allocations were made only to societies whose documentation was complete. Societies with pending requirements are required to submit the necessary documents at the earliest, following which their allocations will be finalized.
3. The students' societies/chapters are required to strictly follow the **GFR rules** for disbursement and expenditures undertaken for activities. They are also required to adhere to the **guidelines for spending of society funds**.
4. All events held after **16th October 2025**, or from the date on which the society's documentation was completed in full, shall be eligible for organization and budgeting.
5. Mid-Year Review: If required, the Committee may conduct a **mid-year review** of the allocations.
