

Event Report 180DC SSCBS - Connexion

Date: 23rd April, 2026 Time: 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Event Overview:

With the objective of strengthening inter-chapter engagement and fostering a collaborative consulting ecosystem, 180 Degrees Consulting SSCBS successfully hosted Connexion, a networking mixer bringing together chapters from across Delhi University. The event saw participation from Hindu College, Sri Venkateswara College, Kirori Mal College, Hansraj College, Sri Guru Gobind Singh College of Commerce and Gargi College, uniting driven and like-minded individuals with a shared interest in problem-solving, strategic thinking and social impact consulting.

Connexion was thoughtfully curated to facilitate meaningful interactions, encourage knowledge exchange and build lasting connections across chapters through a blend of structured activities and open networking. Participants were divided into cross-college teams at the outset, ensuring that every activity doubled as an opportunity to collaborate with peers from unfamiliar chapters.

Session Highlights:

1. Chapter Introductions:

The event opened with a round of chapter introductions, in which representatives from each participating college presented their chapter's structure, ongoing and past projects, recruitment cycles and key initiatives for the term. This segment gave attendees a clear picture of how consulting work is approached across different chapters, surfaced common challenges in project sourcing and client management, and established a shared context that informed the conversations through the rest of the day.

2. Networking Games:

The mixer then moved into a curated set of networking games, each placing participants in cross-college teams and encouraging collaboration under varying constraints.

The opening icebreaker had participants track down the person carrying their name tag, introduce themselves and exchange a light-hearted dare, a few of which were performed at random later. It set an energetic tone and encouraged attendees to step beyond familiar circles from the outset.

The second activity required teams to perform a short skit based on an assigned film, while incorporating a character chosen for them by a rival team. Working within a fixed time limit, teams demonstrated sharp improvisation, quick thinking and strong coordination.

The final activity gave teams a real-world case and ten minutes to build a solution, which they then presented one word per member in a fixed rotation, without notes or any indication of elapsed time. The format tested preparation, listening and the ability to think as a single unit under pressure.

Atmosphere and Engagement:

The event witnessed enthusiastic participation from all six chapters, creating an environment marked by curiosity, energy and camaraderie. Points were tracked across activities on a running leaderboard, which added a healthy competitive edge without detracting from the collaborative spirit of the mixer. The seamless blend of structured games and informal discussions enabled participants to form meaningful professional connections while fostering a sense of community within the broader 180DC network.

Conclusion:

Connexion underscored the importance of inter-chapter collaboration and the value of exchanging ideas within the 180 Degrees Consulting ecosystem. By bringing six Delhi University chapters together in a single room, the event successfully laid the groundwork for continued collaboration, mutual learning and collective growth across the network.
